



Beware of E-ZPass phishing scam

The E-ZPass Interagency Group is reporting a large number of complaints about bogus toll violation notices sent by email (see copy below).

New Jersey drivers should know that legitimate toll violation notices are sent by mail, not email, from the E-ZPass Customer Service Center in Newark, NJ. The web address for paying a legitimate violation to agencies in the New Jersey E-ZPass Group is www.EZPassNJ.com.
