INSTALLATION OF THE FIRST ELECTRIC VEHICLE charging station on the New Jersey Turnpike is scheduled to begin next week. Tesla Motors plans to begin installing a charging station at the Joyce Kilmer Service Area between Interchanges 8A and 9 on the northbound Turnpike. The installation will take between four and six weeks. The company entered into a licensing agreement with the Turnpike Authority in September to install charging stations at one service area on each side of the Turnpike. The other charging station will be installed at the Molly Pitcher Service Area between interchanges 8A and 8 on the southbound Turnpike. In addition to the Tesla charging stations, the Turnpike Authority will soon issue a request for proposals for other EV charging stations to be installed alongside the Tesla facilities at Joyce Kilmer and Molly Pitcher and at locations along the Garden State Parkway.
